**Item 0526/04 To approve the draft notes as minutes of the last meeting held on the 25 February 2026:** RESOLVED to adopt and sign the notes as accurate minutes, and they were dated and signed by the Chair.

**Item 0526/05 Training:** Training available to all Staff and elected Members and clerk recommends councillors to view training schedule. Training for all new councillors was on 3 March. The training was online and the feedback was that it was far too long and repetitive and not the best way to impart this kind of knowledge. Clerk will feedback to LALC.

**Item 0526/06 Parish Matters:**

- a) Graveyards new plan – report from councillors that there had a meeting that the villagers were invited to the plan of leaving the church and graveyard to have areas that are left un-mowed have wild flowers in some areas and not to use weed killer in any part. There was one parishioner that attended meeting and wanted the current way that the graveyard was kept to remain at the same time other villagers wanted a more rustic view. There has been a lengthy debate. This leads to point b new suppliers to be considered for next term 2026/27. Tenders need to be submitted for April meeting.

- b) Grass cutting quotes – councillors sought quotes – first was from G Fawcett £3,200 second was from D Hobson £2,800 – awarded to D Hobson. This was proposed, seconded and RESOLVED. Plan to be published on website and write to both suppliers.
- c) Bullgauds Field – Councillor asked for this to be added to agenda and stated that it needs to be maintained and asked Clerk to write to owner. Proposed, seconded and RESOLVED defer to next meeting.
- d) Jubilee Field ownership – village was canvassed via the village magazine and there has been no been much input from villagers – discussion lead to proposal that we give the field back to owner, seconded and RESOLVED. Clerk to write to owner.
- e) Council owned benches and marquee – there are three benches that are on the Jubilee Field and proposal was made to see if we could sell them to the parishioners – sealed bids to the clerk to be a notice on the noticeboard and village magazine by 26 May seconded and RESOLVED - the highest bidders would and people that can take the benches would be awarded the benches. Marquee – decided to keep in case of future events. Kings Community Trust trees was mentioned but as they are not on the agenda would be defer to next meeting especially as this is not the time to replant them.
